Fear is the consequence, the motivator, and the propagator of It is the hallmark or signature characteristic of a fallen world. A fallen world is a world that has fallen away from Love. God is Love.

Fear Categories:

- Misjudgement/Condemnation/Rejection
- Vulnerability/Subjection to the will of others/Being hurt
- The unpredictable/The unfamiliar/The uncontrollable/ The unknown/

Internal statements of fear:

- People will assume things about me or presume to know me.
- People don't value me. They only care about themselves.
- What if something terrible happens? Everything falls apart. Something bad always happens. I couldn't handle it if...

Fear is a disease. It eats away at our hearts, our minds, and our souls, even our physical bodies until we waste away.

The world gives us so many legit reasons to fear.

God gives us a picture in Psalm 23 of what it looks like to live in a fallen world yet not live according fear.

God sent his Son to be with us so that we would be cured of the disease of fear.

Emmanuel = God with us

All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call Him Immanuel" (which means "God with us"). — Matthew 1:22–23

Why is it important for people to know that God is with them?

The establishing of the body of Christ

- Jesus assured his disciples He'd ______ even until the end.
- He commissioned them to reach the world with his gospel but he commanded them to wait for the coming of the Spirit of Truth who would help them, fill them with power, guide them in all truth, comfort them.
- He told them this was a better way to reach the world then for him to stay on earth in the flesh.
- He gave them his to carry on.
